



THE CARPET INDUSTRY IS GROWING

- Carpet Accounts For More New Floor Covering Installations Than Tile.
- Tile Floor Maintenance Accounts For 20%
 Of Staff Man-hours.
- Carpet Maintenance Now Accounts For 13% Of Staff Man-hours.







FILAMENT SOURCES (FIBERS)

Natural

- Animal (Protein) Wool
 - Most Durable.
 - Finest Of All Fibers.
 - Very Absorbent (Will Stain)
 - Temp. No More Than 110 Degree.
 - Don't Over-Wet.

Fifth Generation Nylon

- Synthetic (Nylon)
 - Acid Dye Resisters Will Pack Dye Sites With Colorless Dye.
 - Not Warranted Against Red Or Yellow Dyes. (Red Soda Pop & Mustard)
 - Warranties Void By Incorrect Cleaning.



Other Commercial Carpet Fibers

Polypropylene (Olefin)

- Least Absorbent Of All Synthetics.
- Loves Oil.
- Must Be Solution Dyed.
- Low Resilience.
- Reacts To Temp. 160-170 Degree.
- Wicking A Problem.
- It Floats.



HOW TO IDENTIFY QUALITY CARPET

- Tufts Per Inch 6-12 Gage (10=Institutional)
- Pull Weight = How Much It Takes To Pull Out A Tuft. 14-20 lbs.. (18=Institutional)
- How Many Ounces Per Yard. Gage 20-50
 Use 45 + Gage For Institutional
- Can Use Scratch Test
 - Easy To See Backing = 6 Gage (Poor Grade)
 - Takes Time To See Backing = 8-9 Gage (Good Grade)
 - Very Hard To See Backing = 10 + (Very Good Grade)




CARPET CONSTRUCTION

Most Carpets Have Three Layers:

- P The Face Fiber (Carpet Pile).
- The Primary Backing. (Holds Face Fibers)
- The Secondary Backing For Dimensional Stability.

Face Fiber

Primary Backing Secondary Backing





CUSHION TYPES

- Hair/Jute Smells When Wet & Will Brown.
- Rubber Waffle Will Soak Up Spills.
- Densified Urethane.
 - ₱ 1/4" Too Hard.
 - ₱ 1/2" Best.
 - ₱ 3/4" Too soft & Will Wear Face Fibers.
- Attached Cushion.
 - Caution When Using Solvents & Cleaners.



PRINCIPALS OF "T.A.C.T."

- T.A.C.T.
 - Time Dwell Time.
 - Action Mechanical Action.
 - Concentration Dilution Rate.
 - Temperature For Every 18 Degrees Over 118 Degrees You Increase The Temperature Of The Cleaning Solution, You Double The Cleaning Strength.



THE CLEANING CYCLE

Wash - Use T.A.C.T..

Rinse - Removes Detergents & Soil.

Dry - Factors Of Dry Time Are:

- Air Movement.
- Air Temperature.
- Relative Humidity.
- Use Of Extra Equipment.
 - Air Conditioning Or Dehumidifiers.





PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

Vacuum Often

- Carpet Soil Make-Up.
 - ₱ 80% From Foot Traffic.
 - ₱ 15% Airborne.
 - § 5% Other.
 - § \$500 To Remove One Pound Of Soil.

Walk Off Mats

- Six Steps Will Clean Shoes.
- Six Steps = A 12 Foot Mat.
- Clean Mats A Min. Once Per Week.
- Remove Spots Often

 - Indoor Air Quality (IAQ)



TYPES OF SPOTS AND STAINS

- Four Types Of Spots.
 - Water Soluble Soft Drinks, Mud etc.
 - Oil Based Petroleum
 - Non Soluble Sand, Grit.
 - Special Treatment Dye Stains, Rust,
 Red Wine etc.
- Check pH Of The Spot If You Are Not Sure What It Is.



SPOT REMOVAL PROCEDURES

- Vacuum Thoroughly.
- Remove Solids By Scraping.
- Remove Moisture By Blotting.
- Apply Spotter To Outside Edge.
- Tamp w/ Soft Brush.
- Allow Proper Dwell Time.
- Blot Treated Area Or Use A Wet Dry Vac.





- Repeat 4,5,6 If Spot Not Removed.
- Always Rinse.
- White Cloth With Weight If Spot Is Reappearing.

CARPET CLEANING METHODS

Vacuuming.

(Daily)

Bonnet Cleaning.


(Interim)

Hot Water Extraction.

(Restorative)

BONNET CLEANING

- Vacuum Carpet.
- Remove Spots.
- Install Driver.
- Dilute Product.
- Soak Yarn Pad.
- Center Pad.
- Buff Six Square Feet.
- Turn Pad.





- Let Carpet Dry.
- Wash Soiled Pad.
- Can also use process of spraying pad and carpet for a faster dry time.

SHAMPOOING

- Remove Furniture.
- Vacuum Carpet.
- Remove Spots.
- Install Shower
 Feed Disk
- Dilute Product.
- Use Overlapping Passes.



- P Don't Over-Wet.
- Set Carpet Pile.
- Allow Carpet To Dry Thoroughly.
- Vacuum To Help Remove Detergent.

HOT WATER EXTRACTION

- Remove Furniture.
- Vacuum Carpet.
- Remove Spots.
- Dilute Pre-spray.
- Dilute Extraction Cleaner.
- Pre-spray Traffic Lanes.





- Check Wand Nozzles.
- Extract The Carpet Using Overlapping Passes.
- Set Carpet Pile.
- Dry Thoroughly.
- P Vacuum.

THE DUAL PROCESS

- Remove Furniture.
- Vacuum Carpet.
- Remove Spots.
- Dilute Shampoo.
- Shampoo Carpet Using Overlapping Passes.
- Dilute Extraction Cleaner.
- Check Wand Nozzles.







- Extract UsingOverlapping Passes.
- Don't Over-Wet.
- Dry Thoroughly.
- Set Carpet Pile.
- Vacuum Carpet.

INDOOR AIR QUALITY (IAQ)
